The committee members participated in a lively brainstorming session and discussion on what our mission should be, and possible approaches to senior tax relief.

A preliminary agenda and scope of activities prepared by Ron Pavlucik was reviewed and modified. It can be modified further as we go forward with our work.

The group agreed to meet on Mondays, with the next meeting set for 5:30 PM on Monday August 29th. Ron will contact the City Clerk to reserve a meeting room. Ron will invite Tax Assessor Gloria Kovac to attend, in order to update the committee on the current tax relief program. Ron will ask Mayor Lauretti to attend, and to provide a "goal" or "charge" for the work we should be doing, including the type of final report to be prepared, and what is the timeframe.

Subject to change, the committee drafted a preliminary goal: "Examine Shelton's current senior tax relief program to determine if changes or enhancements are needed".

The meeting adjourned at about 9 PM.
