Corrections to Minutes

August 1, 2007

MOTION made by Mr. Nappi to approve the Minutes of August 1, 2007, seconded by Mr. Hartman for discussion.

Discussion

- Mr. Nappi requested that the Minutes reflect page numbers and the Agenda Items. I also have corrections:
- Page 2 – Under 757 Long Hill Avenue (I am not trying to be critical) I believe Mr. Sekelsky said I heard nothing from not form the Fire Marshal.
- Page 4 – Under Mr. Adinolfi's comments change m to my foundation.
- Alderman York I don't believe lives at 10 Long Hill Avenue – I thought she lives at Longview Avenue.
- Page 6 – Under Mr. Welch's comments – statues should be statutes. Also in the next sentence it states the commission of Public Health & Safety and I believe the correct statement should be the Commissioner of Public Safety. The fourth line Commission should be Commissioner. Also the sentence The City does not have the ability of adopting stricter regulations than what is provide by the State Blasting Permit Policy based on Alderman Chris Panek putting a list together. I don't believe that is what you said, but I'll leave that to you.

- Just as a point of order, I don't think the secretary should be – after the meeting starts – put audience participation into the Minutes.
- Mr. Nappi asked if we can continue with the agenda and save questions for after the meeting. The correction is Mr. Nappi asked if we can continue with the Agenda and have questions saved for after the meeting.
- Page 7 – Again audience participation.
- Detective Colon stated that several towns have that. A policy of removal bond can be placed. Should be: Detective Colon stated that several Towns have that. A policy of removal and bonds can be placed.
- I don't believe that this sentence is a fair quote from Mr. Welch – Mr. Welch stated and lost.
- Page 10 – Mr. Nappi asked Mr. Schultz since the P&Z Commission is going to make a policy for every time there is blasting and since you have already started mandating pre-basting surveys, we can take it that you are going to do that for all blasting.
- Mr. Nappi stated that I'm confided (should be – confused) are you going to take a pro-active approach to require some type of pre-blasting survey?
- Page 11 – Mr. Nappi stated that Corporate Counsel – should be – Corporation Counsel – says you can't and the State Fire Marshal says you can – should be – can't.
- Mr. Nappi stated your office, not the local Fire Marshal needs to be informed of a violation of State Statutes. Correction – Mr. Nappi stated your office through the local Fire Marshal needs to be informed of a violation of State Statutes.
- Page 12 – Mr. Nappi stated there were 23 permits issued that doesn't mean that there are 21 complaints. (Correction – Mr. Nappi stated there were 23 permits issued that doesn't mean that there are 21 complaints on the 23 permits.)

- Also all the audience participation included in the Minutes.
- Detective Colon stated it is required that they should provide to the Fire Marshal the blasting site. Correction – the blasting site plan.
- Page 13 – There is an entire section of tape that I would ask the clerk to review – when it came down to discussion between the original 17 items and 15, I remember saying from the review the two items eliminated conflicted with State Statutes and Regulations and couldn't be enforced as per the Fire Marshal and that is not in the Minutes.
- Mr. Nappi stated that I asked Mr. Steiner if he had a problem tabling Agenda item 2b and that is not in the Minutes.

Chairman Perillo thanked Mr. Nappi. You are very thorough.

Mr. Jager stated that he has 4 items regarding the Minutes from 8/1/07.

- Page 3 – the entire – the entire input from Mrs. Watters was inaudible because of malfunctioning equipment in this room.
- Page 4 – In Jim Adinolfi's comments – m foundation should be my foundation.
- Page 8 – requires – should be required.
- Multiple times – My name is Jager not Jagers.
