1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Commissioner DeAngelis read the call of the meeting:

LEGAL NOTICE CITY OF SHELTON

At the regular meeting of the City of Shelton Water Pollution Control Authority held on May 14, 2008 the Sewer User Charge Rate for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 was set at one hundred eighty seven dollars (\$187) per residential unit. There shall be one annual billing. These charges were filed with the City/Town Clerk on May 23, 2008. Any appeals from this assessment must be taken within 21 days from said filing. Any person aggrieved by this assessment may appeal to the Superior Court of the judicial district where in the property is located and shall bring any such appeal to a return day of said court not less than twelve (12) nor more than thirty (30) days after service thereof and such appeal shall be privileged in respect to its assignment for trial.

Chairman Michael DeAngelis asked three (3) times if any member of the public wished to address the Board.

Being none, he declared the public session closed.
