PRESS RELEASE 2009 LEAF COLLECTION

During the fall season of 2009, October thru December, the COMPOST SITE will be opened as follows:

<u>EVERY WEEKDAY</u>	October 19 thru December 11	7AM-2PM
<u>SATURDAYS</u>	October 24 thru December 12	7AM-12 NOON
<u>CLOSED</u>	November 11 – Veteran's Day November 26 – Thanksgiving Day	

The **FIRST** citywide curbside collection of bagged leaves (**PAPER BAGS ONLY**) will begin on Monday, **NOVEMBER 16**, and END on Friday, **NOVEMBER 20**. Bagged leaves should be placed at the curbside on the regular trash collection day.

Please be sure to keep leaf bags apart from your regular trash. In the event of a snowstorm, leaf bags should be left out at the curbside. They will be collected as soon as possible.

The **SECOND** and last bagged leaf collection will be the week of Monday, **DECEMBER 7** and end on Friday, **DECEMBER 11**.

Compost Site will be open this week Monday-Friday 7:00 AM – 2 PM and Saturday 7:00AM-12 NOON.

Anyone bringing leaves to the compost site in containers other than paper bags must remove non-conforming container from the site

Paper bags for leaf collection will go on sale at the **Plumb Memorial Library, Shelton Community Center, City Clerk's Office and the Highways and Bridges Complex** on Tuesday, October 20, 2009.
